<i>Prospective Service Offering (Domestic)</i>	Every property will receive a totally unlimited symmetric (upload & download) 1,000 Mbps service for £45 per month inc VAT.	Other broadband service providers offer between 1.2 Mbps to 16 Mbps download typically in the Postford Mill area; future improvements in this speed are extremely uncertain; upload speeds are constrained even further. B4RN infrastructure will enable you to take maximum advantage of online services such as Netflix, VOIP (telephone over internet), use of Cloud storage and emerging data intensive service offerings into the future.
<i>Prospective Service Offering (Businesses with more than 5 employees)</i>	Entirely independent symmetric 1,000 Mbps service probably for under £100 per month (inc VAT)	
<i>Implementation Target</i>	Autumn 2018	Albury and the Tillingbourne Valley only. Future phases being planned for later in 2018 and 2019.
<i>One-off connection costs</i>	One off cost of under £250 for modem and fibre. This also covers the cost of blowing a fibre down the tube and fusing it inside the house.	
<i>Indicative cost model for connection from service provision point on boundary to private home</i>	DIY in garden (laying the tube to the Service Provision Point) then possibly 1/4 day for each property using electrician grade person. It could be cheaper if a group all agrees and a single fibre cable is divided in an external wall box with fibres going to each house.	Each home owner is responsible for providing the connection from the Service Provision Point on the boundary. It will be cheaper to work in groups. Modem fitted to wall by B4SH staff.
<i>Monthly costs</i>	Planning on around £45 inc VAT per month	
<i>Termination of service costs</i>	Zero and 1 month's notice.	
<i>Possible fibre route</i>	Intend to lay a fibre tube starting at Waterloo Pond and loop round behind the properties keeping well clear of most tarmac.	

<i>Support line details \ service levels</i>	English call centre locally eventually but backed by ACTIVE circuit monitoring 24 / 7	Fibre is much more reliable than copper based services; most problems boil down to WIFI problems within households
<i>Disable BT line and avoid associated costs</i>		You can disable the BT line if you wish and transfer your number to a VOIP provider such as Vonage BUT you need battery back-up if you require service during a power outage.
